Objective

Target Group

Concept

The "Multiple Myeloma Assessment Pathway" (M.M.A.P) Medical Education Program/Other Learning Activity (OLA): a web-based application to facilitate discussions between Hem/Oncs with respect to individual patient factors that influence treatment decisions. Physicians have the ability to select the decision factors applicable to a patient they have in mind, and receive suggested treatment options. The treatment options reorder based on the decision factors selected. For further discussion, physicians are also able to review

clinical data directly tied to the suggested treatment regimen.
